Richmond Dairies a Casino based milk processor is doing its part to help its farmers cope with the cost impacts of the drought.

Christopher Sharpe, Managing Director said “We have direct supply farmers stretching from the Macksville area in the south through to the Kenilworth region in South East Queensland”.

“We are acutely aware of the challenges faced by our direct supply farmers due to ongoing drought conditions. As a demonstration of practical support for our farmers, we will provide an additional three [3] cents per litre “drought support payment” on all milk produced from the beginning of August 2018” Christopher Sharpe said.

“We understand that this payment will not solve the current problems facing our farmers, but we believe it will assist with the challenges they are currently facing. We will continue to monitor this on a month by month basis” he said.
